STUDY INFO:

This study is part of the SAFE EUROPE project (www.safeeurope.eu [2]), co-funded by the ERASMUS+ Sector Skills alliances programme of the European Union. It is also part of PhD research that was approved by the Ethics Committee of the University of Ulster (Project Number: FCNUR-21-080).

STUDY AIM:

The aim of this survey is to assess the current radiotherapy advanced practice roles across Europe and identify the educational gaps for this advanced level practice.

IMPORTANT INFO:

Advanced practice is characterised by a high degree of autonomy and complex decision making, delivered by experienced TRs/RTTs underpinned by training. This level of practice encompasses four pillars: clinical practice, leadership and management, education and research with demonstration of core capabilities and area specific clinical competences.

Advanced activities or tasks performed by TRs/RTTs can be wide ranging such as: patient holistic care, advanced image review (e.g. 3D/4D image assessment & decision making), advanced planning, adaptive RT, on-treatment review, physical/remote follow-up, supervision of complex cases and techniques, protocols development, supervision of students, radiotherapy advocacy, etc.

This questionnaire will take about 20 to 30 minutes to complete and consists of three sections:

Section II: Professional profile

Sub-sections: IIA - Advanced practitioner's profile / IIB - TR/RTT's profile
